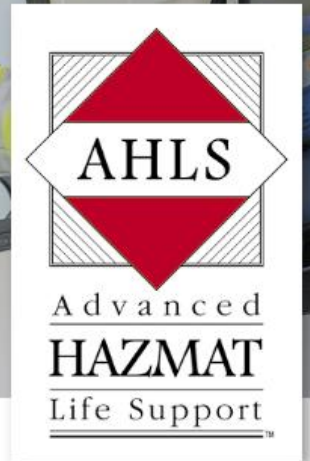


Advanced Hazmat Life Support



The Advanced Hazmat Life Support (AHLS) course is a 16-hour, two-day course that teaches healthcare professionals how to **medically manage** patients exposed to hazardous materials. The focus is on chemical incidents (incl. nerve agents). Incidents with exposure to biological and radiological events are also addressed.

Learning objectives:

- Principle approach to HAZMAT-events
- Self- and partner protection
- Hazardous substance assessment
- Systematic patient assessment
- Toxidromes
- Poisoning treatment paradigm, including specific antidotes

Target audience:

- Emergency physicians, prehospital emergency physicians, paramedics
- Emergency department nurses
- Toxicologists, pharmacologists and pharmacists
- Occupational health physicians
- NBC-specialist firefighters and army staff
- Military physicians and civil protection staff
